



**You can go**

**to Hell!†\***

† Some restrictions apply. See your Bible for details.

Billions of men and women just like you and me have made the decision to go to Hell\*! <sup>1</sup>

What about you? Have you got what it takes?

We would be lying if we told you it will be easy.

It will mean a long, hard struggle.<sup>2</sup> You see, Hell\* is a rather recent option.<sup>3</sup> And it really was not designed with you in mind.<sup>4</sup> It will take persistence and determination. But if you make it, you will be part of an elite group. You will be able to say with the popular singer, “*I did it my way*”<sup>5</sup> In fact, you will have earned the right to say, “*I withstood God!*”<sup>6</sup>

Perhaps we should clear up a few common misunderstandings before we go any further.

A long time ago, even before the beginning of the world, you had already been planned.<sup>7</sup> Someone already knew all about you.<sup>8</sup>

Now, maybe you think that you never were planned – that you just happened by accident.

That’s understandable. Lots of people say that. You may be simply believing what you have been told.

**Many** of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him *John 6:66*  
All that dwell upon the earth shall worship [Antichrist] *Revelation 13:8*
2. It is hard for thee to kick against the [goads] *Acts 9:5*
3. **Every thing** that [God] had made... **was very good** *Genesis 1:31*  
Eternal life... promised before the world began *Titus 1:2*
4. The Lord is... **not willing that any should perish**, but that all should come to repentance *2 Peter 3:9*  
... everlasting fire, **prepared for the devil and his angels** *Matthew 25: 41*  
**I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked**; but that the wicked turn from his way and live *Ezekiel 33:11*  
[God] predestined us unto the adoption of children *Ephesians 1:5*  
[God] will have all men to be saved *1 Timothy 2:4*  
It is **not** the will of your Father which is in heaven, that **one of these little ones should perish** *Matthew 18:14*
5. There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death *Proverbs 14:12*
6. **The Lord is... not willing** that any should perish *2 Peter 3:9*  
How often would I have gathered thy children together... and **ye would not** *Luke 13:34 (also Matthew 23:37)*  
**Ye do always resist** the Holy Ghost *Acts 7:51*
7. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world *Matthew 25:34*  
He hath chosen us... before the foundation of the world *Ephesians 1:4*  
We are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained *Ephesians 2:10*  
An holy calling... given us in Christ Jesus before the world began *2 Timothy 1:9*
8. Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee *Jeremiah 1:5*  
Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all my members were written, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them *Psalms 139:16*  
The very hairs of your head are all numbered *Matthew 10:30*

But of course, if you stop to think about it, you know that things don't create themselves – on their own they just deteriorate. (*That's called entropy.*)

Anyway, the one who created you also claims to love you.<sup>9</sup>

Now it may not surprise you that someone would like you. After all, aren't you basically a good person? Aren't most of us? Sure, there are some bad people out there, but on the whole, aren't most people pretty good deep down inside? And you're probably as good as the next guy, maybe even better. Right?<sup>10</sup>

But suppose someone knew everything you ever did. Including everything you have ever done when no one was looking. And everything you would have done if you thought you could have gotten away with it. Suppose someone knew everything you ever thought. What would that person think of you? How much would they like you?

Well, the fact is, the one who planned you and made you also knows all about you.<sup>11</sup> And he loves you anyway.

9. God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son *John 3:16*  
His great love wherewith he loved us *Ephesians 2:4*  
Christ... hath loved us *Ephesians 5:2*  
The kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared *Titus 3:4*  
God so loved us *1 John 4:11*  
He loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins *1 John 4:10*
10. There is a generation that are pure in their own eyes *Proverbs 30:12*  
All the ways of a man are clean in his own eyes ... *Proverbs 16:2*

The LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts *1 Chronicles 28:9*  
Thou only, knowest the hearts of all the children of men *1 Kings 8:39*  
I the LORD search the heart *Jeremiah 17:10*  
God knoweth your hearts *Luke 16:15*  
Thou hast searched me, and known me. Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off. Thou compassed my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways. For there is not a word in my tongue, but... thou knowest it altogether *Psalms 139:1-4*

Isn't that wonderful? Doesn't that just go to show that despite any flaws you may have, you're pretty good?

Actually, right here is where it gets rather offensive: Believe it or not, the one who planned you, and made you, and knows all about you, and even loves you, happens to think you are not that great. In fact, he thinks you are very bad.<sup>12</sup> He thinks that there is absolutely nothing good about you.<sup>13</sup>

Pretty insulting stuff, isn't it?

So much for that.

Now back to Hell\*.

As we said at the beginning: it's not easy to get to Hell\*. You see, the same person who thinks you're so bad will also do everything he can to prevent you from making it there. He will give you directions to somewhere else,<sup>14</sup> send his assistants,<sup>15</sup> even deliberately put things in your way.<sup>16</sup>

12. Ye then, being evil *Matthew 7:11*

The imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth *Genesis 8:21*

The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked *Jeremiah 17:9*

The wickedness of man was great... every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually *Genesis 6:5*

We are all as an unclean thing *Isaiah 64:6*

13. There is none good but one, that is, God

*Matthew 19:17, also Mark 10:18, Luke 18:19*

There is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not *Ecclesiastes 7:20*

There is none righteous, no, not one... none that understandeth... none that seeketh after God. They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one. Their throat is an open [tomb]; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps is under their lips: Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness: Their feet are swift to shed blood: Destruction and misery are in their ways

*Romans 3:10-16, quoting Psalm 14:1-3, 5:9, 10:7, 36:1, Isaiah 59:7*

In me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing *Romans 7:18*

Thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked *Revelation 3:17*

14. Enter ye in at the strait gate... strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life *Matthew 7:13-14*

Whither I go ye know, and the way ye know *John 14:4*

15. The angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise... lest thou be consumed *Genesis 19:15*

The angel of the Lord spake unto Philip, saying, Arise, and go *Acts 8:26*

I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things *Revelation 22:16*

16. [Balaam] saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way *Numbers 22:31*

The LORD sent out a great wind into the sea *Jonah 1:4*

Suddenly there shined round about [Paul] a light from heaven *Acts 9:3*

**My spirit** shall not always **strive with man** *Genesis 6:3*

As a matter of fact, he is so determined to prevent you from reaching your goal that, if there is no other way, he is even prepared to die to stop you.

(That's the kind of 'religious extremist' we're dealing with.)

Now at this point you might be asking,  
"Why is he so determined? What's in it for him?"

Plenty. Don't forget, he loves you.

So what? Lots of people love you, right?

But this is different.

You see, this person is actually the source of all love.<sup>17</sup> He loves you because of who *he* is, not because of who *you* are.<sup>18</sup> His love is a lot more serious than what we are used to.<sup>19</sup> So it makes sense that he probably wants to be with you.<sup>20</sup> And Hell\* is one place he will not go.

And, of course, he wants you to love him too.<sup>21</sup>

17. Love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God... for God is love  
*1 John 4:7-8 (also v.16)*

18. Christ died for the ungodly... God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us... when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son *Romans 5:6,8,10*

He first loved us *1 John 4:19*

Christ... suffered for sins, the just for the unjust *1 Peter 3:18*

Even when we were dead in sins, [God] hath quickened us together with Christ... That... he might show... his kindness toward us *Ephesians 2:5,7*

19. The love of Christ... passeth knowledge *Ephesians 3:19*

[Christ] hath given himself for us an offering *Ephesians 5:2*

As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you *John 15:9*

Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends  
*John 15:13*

I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep... I lay down my life for the sheep *John 10:11,15,18*

20. I go to prepare a place for you...I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also *John 14:2,3*

We... shall be caught up together... to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord *1 Thessalonians 4:17*

I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me *Revelation 3:20*

The tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God *Revelation 21:3*

I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee *Hebrews 13:5*

Neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord *Romans 8:38-39*

I am with you always, even unto the end of the world *Matthew 28:20*

21. Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength

*Mark 12:30 (also Matthew 22:37, Luke 10:27) quoting Deuteronomy 6:5*

And he knows you won't do that in Hell\*.<sup>22</sup>

But there's more to it than that.

As you may have suspected, he would also want you to work for him.<sup>23</sup>

Truth be told, he would actually want you to worship him and obey him.<sup>24</sup>

And only him.<sup>25</sup>

22. There shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth [in the furnace of fire, the outer darkness] *Matthew 8:12 (also 13:42,50, 22:13, 24:51, 25:30, Luke 13:28)*  
And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God... and they repented not to give him glory... and they gnawed their tongues for pain, And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds. *Revelation 16:9-11 does not refer to Hell, but does show the defiance with which condemned sinners respond to judgment.*
23. This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent *John 6:29*  
He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also *John 14:12*  
We are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works *Ephesians 2:10*  
Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world *James 1:27*  
We are labourers together with God *1 Corinthians 3:9*  
They which have believed in God... be careful to maintain good works *Titus 3:8*  
Let us do good unto all men *Galatians 6:10*  
By works was faith made perfect? *James 2:22*
24. Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God *Matthew 4:10, quoting Deuteronomy 6:13*  
True worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him *John 4:23 (also v.24)*  
If ye love me, keep my commandments *John 14:15 (also v.21)*  
If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love *John 15:10*  
Be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only *James 1:22*  
This is love, that we walk after his commandments *2 John 6*  
Present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God *Romans 12:1*
25. [God] only shalt thou serve *Matthew 4:10, quoting Deuteronomy 6:14*  
Thou shalt have no other gods before me *Exodus 20:3*  
No man can serve two masters *Matthew 6:24*  
I am the way... no man cometh unto the Father, but by me *John 14:6*  
There is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved *Acts 4:12*  
Other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ *1 Corinthians 3:11*

And what's even more outrageous:  
He really thinks that this is what is best for you.<sup>26</sup>

In fact, not only does he think that serving and obeying him is the perfect use for your life, he actually believes that any and every other use is a completely wasted and ruined life.<sup>27</sup>

If you follow this line of reasoning far enough you can see that what he's really insisting on is that you never, ever, do anything without asking him first, and that whatever he says, goes. Period.<sup>28</sup>

(It's starting to sound a lot like a cult, isn't it?)

26. Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me... and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light *Matthew 11:28-30*

His commandments are not grievous *1 John 5:3*

These things have I spoken unto you... that your joy might be full... that in me ye might have peace *John 15:11, 16:33*

27. Our light affliction... worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory *2 Corinthians 4:17*

We labour, that... we may be accepted of him. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad *2 Corinthians 5:9,10 (also see Romans 14:10,12)*

Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide... he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire *1 Corinthians 3:13-15*

Every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment *Matthew 12:36*

Whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting... in due season we shall reap *Galatians 6:7-9*

28. Pray without ceasing *1 Thessalonians 5:17*

Man shall not live by bread al one, but by every word of God *Luke 4:4 (also Matthew 4:4) quoting Deuteronomy 8:3*

"My Lord and my God" *John 20:28*

Hath not the potter power over the clay? *Romans 9:21*

Thy will be done in earth as it is in heaven *Matthew 6:10*

Yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God *Romans 6:13*

"Lord, what wilt thou have me to do?" *Acts 9:6*

Now, he softens this a bit by saying that, while nothing you decide to do on your own can ever please him,<sup>29</sup> he will give you everything you need to do his work.<sup>30</sup>

But then, instead of assuring you that working for him will be fun, he promises that it will often bring you sorrow.<sup>31</sup>

**29.** All our righteousnesses are as filthy rags *Isaiah 64:6*

A man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ *Galatians 2:16*

Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God *Acts 8:21*

God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands; Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things *Acts 17:24-25*

Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD... unto Cain and to his offering [the LORD] had not respect... without shedding of blood is no remission [of sin] *Genesis 4:3,5 and Hebrews 9:22*

Without me ye can do nothing *John 15:5*

**30.** If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you *John 15:7*

If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it *John 14:14*

If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God...

If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink *John 7:17,37*

All things work together for good to them that love God... called according to his purpose... He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? *Romans 8:28,32*

According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness *2 Peter 1:3*

God... worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure *Philippians 2:13*

**31.** Ye shall weep and lament... and ye shall be sorrowful *John 16:20, also v.22*  
We must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God *Acts 14:22*

Instead of guaranteeing good health,  
he warns of pain and suffering.<sup>32</sup>

Instead of prosperity,  
he offers poverty.<sup>33</sup>

32. They will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you

*Matthew 10:17*

They [shall] deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you *Matthew 24:9*

They have persecuted me, they will also persecute you *John 15:20*

The time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service *John 16:2*

We are troubled on every side... perplexed... Persecuted... cast down... Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus... For we which live are always delivered unto death for Jesus' sake *2 Corinthians 4:8-11*

In afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, In stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labours, in watchings, in fastings... unknown... dying  
*2 Corinthians 6:4,5,9*

In labours... stripes [whippings]... prisons... deaths... beaten with rods... stoned... in journeyings... in perils of waters... of robbers... in perils by mine own countrymen... by the heathen... in the city... in the wilderness... in the sea... among false brethren... in weariness and painfulness, in watchings *2 Corinthians 11:23-27*

Others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings... of bonds and imprisonment: They were stoned... sawn asunder... tempted... slain with the sword  
*Hebrews 11:36-37*

All that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution *2 Timothy 3:12*

For thy sake we are killed all the day long *Romans 8:36 quoting Psalm 44:22*

33. The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head *Matthew 8:20, also Luke 9:58*

We both hunger, and thirst, and are naked, and are buffeted, and have no certain dwellingplace *1 Corinthians 4:11*

In hunger and thirst, in fastings...in cold and nakedness *2 Corinthians 11:27*

Poor... having nothing *2 Corinthians 6:10*

They wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented... they wandered in deserts, and in mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth *Hebrews 11:37-38*

Having food and raiment let us be therewith content *1 Timothy 6:8*

And rather than prestige,  
working for him will likely make you very unpopular.

In fact, most people will really hate you.<sup>34</sup>

What he seems to be saying, then, is this:

“Hand your whole life over to me to spend my way  
and, trust me, you’ll be happier for reasons that make  
no sense to you now.”<sup>35</sup>

Now, despite the incredible audacity of this proposal,  
you have to admit that at first glance it does have a  
strange sort of appeal.

After all, it would mean no more worrying.<sup>36</sup>

No more having to make decisions all on your own.<sup>37</sup>

No more wondering if you are getting your fair share  
out of life.<sup>38</sup>

And on and on:

34. Ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake  
*Matthew 10:22, also 24:9, Mark 13:13, Luke 21:17*  
Marvel not... if the world hate you *1 John 3:13*

The world... hated me before it hated you. If ye were of the world, the world  
would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you  
out of the world, therefore the world hateth you *John 15:18-19*  
We are despised... reviled... defamed *1 Corinthians 4:10,12-13*

35. They departed... rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for  
his name *Acts 5:41*  
As Sorrowful, yet always rejoicing... as having nothing, and yet possessing all  
things *2 Corinthians 6:10*

Rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his  
glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy *1 Peter 4:13*  
The peace of God... passeth all understanding *Philippians 4:7*

36. Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet  
for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the  
body than raiment? Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do  
they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye  
not much better than they?... And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider  
the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:... if  
God so clothe the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is cast into  
the oven, shall he not much more clothe you ...? Therefore take no thought,  
saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we  
be clothed?... for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these  
things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all  
these things shall be added unto you. Take therefore no thought for the  
morrow *Matthew 6:25-34*

Be careful for nothing *Philippians 4:6*

37. If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally...  
and it shall be given him *James 1:5*

Ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things *1 John 2:20*

38. Whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also. And if  
any man will... take away thy coat, let him have thy cloak also. And whosoever  
shall compel thee to go a mile, go with him twain. Give to him that asketh thee,  
and from him that would borrow of thee turn not thou away *Matthew 5:39-42*  
Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right? *Genesis 18:25*

No more fear of failure.<sup>39</sup>

For that matter, no more fear of anything.<sup>40</sup>

(This is exactly the sort of thing that makes cults so attractive to some people.)

But think again.

It also means no more personal ambition.<sup>41</sup>

No more pride in your accomplishments.<sup>42</sup>

And no more feeling good about yourself when you do something “good”.<sup>43</sup>

39. I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me *Phillipians 4:13*  
We are more than conquerors through him that loved us *Romans 8:37*
40. God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind *2 Timothy 1:7*  
There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear *1 John 4:18*  
Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth *John 14:27*  
When they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you *Matthew 10:19 (also Mark 13:11, Luke 12:11-12)*  
If God be for us, who can be against us? *Romans 8:31*
41. Not my will, but thine, be done *Luke 22:42 (also Matthew 26:39, Mark 14:36)*  
Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth... Take... no thought for the morrow *Matthew 6:19,34*  
No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier *2 Timothy 2:4*  
Seek those things which are above... Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth *Colossians 3:1-2*  
Whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant *Matthew 20:27 (also Mark 9:35; 10:44)*
42. The good that I would, I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do... with the flesh [I serve] the law of sin *Romans 7:19,25*  
Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh? *Galatians 3:3*  
Whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted *Matthew 23:12*  
Every one that is proud in heart is an abomination to the LORD *Proverbs 16:5 (also 21:4, Psalms 101:5, etc.)*
43. Many that were rich cast in much. And... a certain poor widow... threw in two mites... this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury: For all they did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, even all her living *Mark 12:41-44 (also Luke 21:1-4)*  
Whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all *James 2:10 (also see Galatians 3:10)*

In fact it means no more feeling good about yourself at all because, remember, the person who would be running your life thinks your *self* is completely bad.<sup>44</sup>

And so we have come back to your decision to go to Hell\*.

It actually seems much clearer now, doesn't it?

Live as You want,<sup>45</sup>

44. The publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner *Luke 18:13*  
I am carnal, sold under sin... In me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing... O wretched man that I am! *Romans 7:14,18,24*  
I am vile *Job 40:4*  
I abhor myself, and repent in dust and ashes *Job 42:6*  
Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips *Isaiah 6:5*

When the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law  
*Genesis 3:15; Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:21; Galatians 4:4*

The waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh... But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word... reserved unto fire... I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved... and shall not come into condemnation but is passed from death unto life... For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ  
*Genesis 9:15; 2 Peter 3:7; John 10:9; 5:24; 1 Thessalonians 5:9*

God will provide himself a lamb for a[n]... offering... Take to them every man a lamb... Your lamb shall be without blemish... The whole assembly... shall kill it in the evening... and when I see the blood, I will pass over you... Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world

He hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows... he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed... the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all... he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken... he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors... Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners... gave himself a ransom for all... He hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him... Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God... Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us... No man taketh [my life] from me, but I lay it down of myself

He said, **It is finished:** and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost *John 19:30*

(And no cult leader ever rose from the dead.)

Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was crucified: **he is risen**; he is not here: behold the place where they laid him. Now when **Jesus was risen** early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene... Afterward he appeared unto the eleven... and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after **he was risen**  
*Mark 16:6,9,14 (also Matthew 28:6-7)*

... the third time that Jesus showed himself to his disciples, after... he was **risen from the dead** *John 21:14*

This Jesus hath God **raised up**, whereof we all are witnesses *Acts 2:32*  
[Ye] killed the Prince of life, whom God hath **raised from the dead**; whereof we are witnesses *Acts 3:15*

With great power gave the apostles witness of the **resurrection of the Lord Jesus** *Acts 4:33*

And we are witnesses of all things which he did both in the land of the Jews, and in Jerusalem; whom they slew and hanged on a tree: Him God **raised up** the third day, and showed him openly... unto witnesses chosen before of God, even to us, who did eat and drink with him after **he rose from the dead** *Acts 10:39-41*

He hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath **raised him from the dead** *Acts 17:31*

The gospel of God (which he had promised afore by his prophets in the holy scriptures) Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the **resurrection from the dead** *Romans 1:1-4*

Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures... was buried, and... **rose again** the third day according to the scriptures... he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve: After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present... After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles. And last of all he was seen of me also *1 Corinthians 15:3-8*

We have not followed cunningly devised fables... but were eyewitnesses of his majesty *2 Peter 1:16 (also see Acts 22:15)*

You really can go to Hell\* if You want it badly enough.

But You will have to withstand God, who has done everything possible to stop You.

If taking control of Your own life is more important to You than anything else, then You have ‘the right stuff’, and You are well on Your way.

But if you are one of those people who is *willing* to surrender to the One who died for you, to put your whole future in the hands of Another, then there is not much hope of you making it to Hell\*. In fact, if that is how little it matters to you to be your own boss – to be the master of your own life – then the only way you are going to get to Hell\* is ...

... by putting off your decision.

We thought it was important for you to have all the facts so you could make the choice that’s right for you.

After all, this may be your last chance.

Prepare to meet thy God *Amos 4:12*

Seek ye the LORD while he may be found *Isaiah 55:6*

This night thy soul shall be required of thee *Luke 12:20*

The night is far spent *Romans 13:12*

Now is the accepted time... now is the day of salvation *2 Corinthians 6:2*

And forever never ends.
